For nearly 150 years, the American Bar Association has shaped the legal profession in the United States, establishing ethical standards, influencing legal education, and guiding the evolution of legal practice.

The ABA Law Library Collection: Books & Practice Materials Archive brings that legacy together in a comprehensive digital archive of ABA publications, including both widely distributed works and previously hard-to-access practice materials. Preserved through decades of print and microfiche preservation efforts, these publications document how law has been practiced, taught, and developed across generations.

*Additional materials are currently being digitized, with the full archive expected to reach nearly 9,000 titles upon completion in November 2026.*

Hein has preserved ABA materials for decades in microfiche and now, for the first time, brings the fully digitized archive online, built on original MARC records to support precise discovery and seamless integration.
