

U.S. Federal Agency Documents, Decisions, and Appeals

The U.S. Federal Agency Documents, Decisions, and Appeals database is a collection of the official case law of some of the United States' most important government institutions. This case law, also known as decision law, is the body of reported judicial opinions that are published by each agency and thereby become precedent and the basis for future decisions.

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Decisions of the National Labor Relations Board (1934-Current)

The National Labor Relations Board is an independent federal agency vested with the power to safeguard employees' rights to organize and to determine whether to have unions as their bargaining representative. The agency also acts to prevent and remedy unfair labor practices committed by private sector employers and unions. On the adjudicative side of the NLRB are 40 Administrative Law Judges who docket, hear, settle, and decide unfair labor practice cases throughout the country and a Board whose five members, appointed by the President and confirmed by the Senate, primarily act as a quasi-judicial body in deciding cases on the basis of formal records in administrative proceedings.

Federal Communications Commission Record (1986-Current)

The Federal Communications Commission regulates interstate and international communications by radio, television, wire, satellite, and cable in all 50 states, the District of Columbia and U.S. territories. An independent U.S. government agency overseen by Congress, the FCC is the United States' primary authority for communications laws, regulation and technological innovation. The FCC Record is a comprehensive compilation of decisions, reports, public notices, and other documents of the Federal Communications Commission from 1986 to the present.

Internal Revenue Cumulative Bulletin (1919-2008, All Published)

The Internal Revenue Service is the nation's tax collection agency and administers the Internal Revenue Code enacted by Congress. This bulletin presents announcements of official rulings and procedures, treasury decisions, executive orders, tax conventions, legislation, and court decisions. It also contains other items of general interest intended to promote a uniform application of the tax laws.
